Benjamin Fisher and his wife Rosanna were probably buried on their farm in Clermont County, G Ohio. They owned 345 acres of land there and the date of the deed was June 24, 1808. An invent 17, 1818 showed a man of substantial material wealth.

Benjamin Fisher left no will, but there was a Petition for Partition of the estate filed at the Commo Williamsburg, Clermont County, Ohio, Book E pg. 292 which shows the names of all his children.

Benjamin Fisher and some friends (John Colip and Jacop Hiers) went to a man named Shintapper axes as he was the only one around with a grindstone. Shortly after their arrival Indians came into Shintapper because he had mistreated several Indians, including burning one so badly that he was three men could not stand by and watch Shintapper be killed so they help to fight off the Indians. Only to return with clubs to fight back. One Indian hit Shintapper with a club knocking him down and an Indian on the head and killed him. Then the battle waged fiercer than ever. When retreating from Benjamin Fisher fell and at once was tomahawked by the Indians. The Indians then gathered up and went away.

Charles Fisher had the tomahawk and pieces of his father's skull. Shintapper loaded his goods in a canoe and his wife and child went down White River and was never heard from again. Benjamin Fisher was buried in Strawtown near where he was killed. His grave is what is now known as Strawtown Cemetery.

Fishersburg was named for Benjamin Fisher.
