ON LEAF LESSON VI.

43. To him bear all the prophetic witness.—This is the drift and the sum prophetic testimony. Through his name.—Hence the argument: "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ, for the remission of sins" (Acts ii. 38). And hence, in the present instance, these believers were commanded to be baptized "in the name of Jesus Christ" (verse 48). Everyone that believeth in him.—Observe: (1) anyone, Gentile as well as Jew; (2) "that believeth in him;" it is a personal and personal Saviour, as able to save whosoever believeth in him. Remission of sins.—Forgiveness of sins.
4. While Peter yet spoke. The word.—See chap. xi. 15: "as on us beginning;" in the same miraculous way, with the same directness, coming the same gifts, as on the day of Pentecost; thus marking out the Gentiles entitled to the same gospel blessings as the Jews. See chap. xi. 15-18. Read fully the remaining verses of chap. xi. 1-18.

LESSONS.

It is a precious truth that "God is no respecter of persons" (34); that his love is for "all."
It is a very solemn truth that God is no respecter of character (35).
The same Christ, the same gospel, the same conditions of salvation are offered to Gentiles as to Jews; and the
